



Adoption Guidelines

STEP 1: Purchase new gifts & gift cards

Please provide at least two new gifts or gift cards (min. \$25 per gift) per child based on their wish list. Gifting is optional for adult wish list items. We ask that you also provide a one \$35 gift card for each adult and \$25 per child for groceries. To assist families with any potential issues, we kindly request that you include all gift receipts for all items, including gift cards in a separate envelope.

STEP 2: Pack the gifts & gift cards

Be as creative as you want with the gifts and/or gift cards (i.e. stockings, gift boxes, bags). Please place gift cards and in a gift box or envelope with the recipient's name.

STEP 3: Label the gifts

Clearly label the outside of the gift box or envelopes with the recipient name. You may handwrite the code or use a sticker/label. Your attention to detail ensures that each family receives their holiday surprises with ease and joy.

STEP 4: Prepare for delivery

Place ALL the gifts in one or more large sturdy box that can be completely closed and secured with tape, keeping them together for the entire family. A plastic tote box is a great option for keeping gifts together and as a bonus, the family can reuse the tote for storage! Please label the box with the unique **Family Code**.

STEP 5: Drop off the gifts

Once all gifts for your family have been packaged properly, drop it off at the OC Fair & Event Center (905 Arlington Drive, Costa Mesa, CA 92626 - Gate Entrance 8):

- Sunday, December 14 from 9 am - 3 pm
- Monday, December 15 from 8 am - 4 pm

Bike Guidelines

Each year, we receive several requests for bikes. If purchasing a bike(s) for your adopted family, we kindly request that you:

- Include a helmet and a lock with each bike
- Do NOT wrap the bike
 - If preassembled, do not wrap (you can put a bow on it)
 - If in a box, do not assemble or wrap (our team will assemble and test the bike before delivering to the family)
- Please use a tag to label each bike with the unique **Family Code** (no stickers please)
